On behalf of everyone at Mercedes AMG High Performance Powertrains (HPP) and Mercedes-Benz, we would like to thank you once again for the contribution that you have made towards our success in the 2019 Formula One season, allowing us to win the World Championship title and achieve a new record of six consecutive Constructors' and Drivers' World Championships in a row.
